

Single Stream Recycling Tips

- ◆ Place ALL recyclables (paper, plastic, metal, cardboard and glass) inside your RECYCLE cart.
- ◆ DO NOT mix garbage or yard waste with recyclables
- ◆ Place your cart curbside by 6 a.m. on your scheduled day.
- ◆ Be sure cart has lid opening facing the street.

Acceptable Recycling items

Paper

Newspapers, junk mail, magazines, telephone books, catalogues, office paper and brown paper bags.

Plastic

Bleach, detergent, shampoo bottles and bottles with necks. **NO PLASTIC BAGS. NO STYROFOAM. PLEASE RINSE.**

Metal

Aluminum and aerosol cans, pie pans, steel food containers. **PLEASE RINSE.**

Cardboard

Food boxes, milk and juice containers and cardboard boxes. Please flatten cardboard boxes and limit size to 2 feet by 2 feet.

Glass

Green, clear and brown bottles and jars. **PLEASE RINSE**

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS:

BULK ITEMS (FURNITURE, MATTRESSES, ETC.)

- ◆ Collection of these items will be with your regular curbside garbage. However, large item collection is limited to 3 cubic yards. Additional charges for this service may apply if amount exceeds three cubic yards.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS (CONCRETE, BRICKS, LUMBER, ETC.)

- ◆ Collection of this material is not part of the Universal Solid Waste Program. For more information on C&D disposal, please contact the Solid Waste Department.

WHITE GOODS (WASHERS, DRYERS, REFRIGERATORS)

- ◆ White goods must be Freon free prior to collection at curb.
- ◆ To ensure public's safety, please remove doors from appliances.
- ◆ This service is provided free of charge to residents.
- ◆ To schedule collection of a white good, please contact your service provider or the Solid Waste Department.

Per County Ordinance, please DO NOT place your garbage curbside earlier than 6 p.m. the night before scheduled pick up and remove promptly after collection. Garbage should be placed within 3 feet of your curb by 6 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.

ALL RESIDENTS IN UNINCORPORATED OSCEOLA COUNTY WILL RECEIVE ONCE A WEEK GARBAGE COLLECTION, ONCE A WEEK YARD WASTE COLLECTION AND ONCE A WEEK SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING COLLECTION. TWO COMPANIES WORKING UNDER CONTRACT WITH OSCEOLA COUNTY ARE ASSIGNED SPECIFIC COLLECTION ZONES TO PROVIDE THIS SERVICE TO THE RESIDENTS.

YARD WASTE IS COLLECTED EVERY WEDNESDAY.

ALL RESIDENTS IN UNINCORPORATED OSCEOLA COUNTY WILL RECEIVE A 96 GALLON RECYCLE CART THAT WILL BE SERVICED CURBSIDE ONCE PER WEEK.

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

This does not include yard waste, hazardous waste or construction and demolition materials.

- Household garbage shall be placed in garbage receptacles no larger than 45 gallons with detachable lids.
- Garbage shall not be commingled with yard waste or recyclables.
- Containers should have two handles, a detachable lid and shall not exceed 50 pounds when full.

YARD WASTE

This includes grass clippings, tree branches, palm fronds, etc. (tied and bundled)

- All bundles/bags/containers must not exceed 50 pounds.
- Collection is LIMITED to 10 bags/bundles/containers per yard waste collection day.
- Branches, tree limbs and palm fronds are not to exceed 4 feet in length, 4 inches in diameter and must be tied and bundled.

RECYCLING

Please refer to our tips on the back of this brochure for proper placement of recyclables at curb.

- SINGLE STREAM recycling means "All Recyclables go into ONE cart"
- Remember: Recycle cart is for recyclables ONLY. Absolutely NO garbage or yard waste in recycle carts.
- Recycle carts used for garbage and yard waste will be left at the curb.
